Gameplay:

LudoSpeak is the game of Ludo with a twist.

To play, you will need: this board, a dice and four tokens for each player.

Move in a clockwise direction.

Start the journey by rolling a 6 on the dice and taking the token out of the start area. Then move forward based on number on the dice.

If a token lands on a square occupied by an opponent's token, the opponent's token is sent back to its starting area. (Make sure to apologise and say 'sorry!'). To get a token into your home area, you need to roll the exact number required.

The first player to get all four of their tokens into their home area wins.

Look out for the Speech Squares:

Eight of the squares are 'Positive Speech' and eight of them are 'Negative speech'. When you land on these squares, answer a question (see the inner flaps quide).

You will have to answer the question starting with the letter based on the number you rolled.

If you answer the question correctly - remain on the square. If you answer incorrectly, take your token back to its previous spot and miss your turn.

EXAMPLES





If you roll a 4 and land on this positive GHI square, then you will need to give a bracha to another player beginning with the letter G, H or I.





Or if you roll a 2 and land on this negative TUV square, then you will need to give an example of Geneivat Da'at beginning with the letter T, U or V.
